In any case, we have to realize that the interventions are becoming more massive and are affecting more and more countries. WAFDAL, together with its members, would like to become more active here and take action against the restrictions.

In spring, we published breeding recommendations for which we received a lot of feedback. Among other things, we show how responsibly Dalmatian breeders have always voluntarily handled their breed. Many discussions have shown us how important such topics are. We will continue to address such issues in discussions with our members.

The highlight of the year, however, was our members meeting and show in Nieuwegein, Holland. The meeting was harmonious and constructive, and Liliane de Ridder and Annemiek Morgans were made honorary members. The show brought together more than 100 Dalmatians and exhibitors from seven countries. Spectators from near and far, as well as the judges from England and New Zealand, contributed to the success of the day. The NCDH organization team did a great job! The day became even more special when our Belgian friends presented their newly donated trophy "The memorial Frans de Ridder interim cup" to the winner. Once again, we saw how nice it is to bring Dalmatian friends together in one place. We are also planning to bring the Dalmatian world together in 2024.
